



Pike County Public Works Monthly Report

June 4th, 2026 – July 3rd, 2026

Work Orders

- Installed speed limit signs between 8367 Old Zebulon Road and Roberts Quarters Road
- Cleaned out culvert at the intersection of Patton Road and Wentworth Way
- Built the shoulder up along the edge of the road at the intersection of Chapel Hill and Hutchinson Farm Road
- Patched two holes near the Dollar General on Bottoms Road at Highway 18
- Tore out beaver dams that were built at the culvert that was causing flooding on Daniel Road
- Removed all vegetation from the dam of the watershed and riser at Green Street Meansville watershed; also removed all trees from the plunge pool for the NRCS
- Removed all vegetation from dam as well as plunge pool and riser. Repaired huge wash out near plunge pool on outlet of dam that had bad erosion with dirt, rip rap, and grass mat at the Alexander Road Watershed for the NRCS
- Removed all vegetation from dam as well as removed down trees from plunge pool and riser at the Harden Road Watershed for the NRCS
- Removed dead deer from the intersection of Old Zebulon Road and Howell Road
- Removed large fallen tree on Madden Road
- Removed load of construction debris that was dumped on the edge of McKinley Road
- Replaced No Thru Traffic sign and misspelled road name sign on Ginger Cake Road
- Mowed all low hanging limbs and brush growing near the edge of the road near 1025 Shortcut Road. As well as clipped high shoulders throughout the full length of the road that was encroaching into the asphalt causing the road to be narrow.
- Cleaned out culvert with high pressure water truck as well as repaired washed out part of the road near the culvert and driveway at 426 Dunbar School Road
- Installed two Blind Drive signs near Apple Lane on Williamson Zebulon Road
- Repaired potholes and washouts with motor grader at 223 Arthur Road
- Removed dead deer near 2380 Chappel Hill Road
- Removed dead dog near 19 Wilder Road
- Tore down beaver dam blocking culvert on Daniel Road
- Cut back trees that have grown out into the road near 2248 Weems Road
- Cleaned out ditches on Hagans Mountain Road where water was jumping across the road and causing a washout

- Cleaned out drains at the intersection of Williams Trail and Ethridge Mill Road
- Removed fallen tree that was blocking both lanes of Buffinton Road
- Repaired large pothole on Williamson Zebulon Road
- Replaced faded stop sign at the intersection of Plantation Road and Honeysuckle Lane
- Laid rock on muddy area of Russell Road where it intersects New Hope Road
- Laid rock on muddy areas of Flowers Road
- Removed fallen tree from across the road near 220 Hillcrest Street
- Removed fallen tree from across the road on Spring Road
- Repaired washed out area of road and potholes at 4801 Blanton Mill Road
- Removed tree that had fallen and was lodged against another tree on Mountain View Road
- Cut back trees that were hanging out onto the road near the intersection of Eppenger Bridge Road and Collier Road
- Removed mattress that was dumped on 2nd District Road
- Cleaned out culvert and ditches at 731 Tanyard Road
- Repaired the intersection at Rawlins Road and Tanyard Road to keep rainwater from washing mud onto Tanyard Road
- Repaired large rut from washout as well as cleaned out ditches and culvert at 152 Wright Road
- Removed dead deer on Bates Road
- Cut back tree that was hanging out onto the road between 971 and 777 Harden Road
- Installed road name signs at the 3-way stop at Watering Hole Pass and Ranchland Gap
- Cut back low hanging limbs at the stop sign near 312 Watering Hole Pass
- Repaired bad washout near 2235 West Road
- Repaired bad washout near the intersection of Reams Road and Bagwell Road
- Removed fallen tree blocking the road near 903 Gaulding Road
- Repaired and patched three large areas of Twin Oaks Road with hot mix asphalt that were falling apart due to trash truck traffic
- Replaced rotted Cross Road Ahead sign near 921 Old Lifsey Springs Road
- Cut back low hanging limbs that were covering signs near the bridge on Kings Bridge Road
- Removed dead deer near 2873 Old Lifsey Springs Road
- Mowed paved and dirt portions of 2nd District Road
- On Call removed several downed trees blocking the roads after the major storm on June 18th-19th. Gaulding Road(X2), Mean Street, Old Fayetteville Road, Mount View Road, Shackelford Road, 2nd Street, and Harden Road
- Cleaned out culvert at 410 Dunn Road
- Cleaned out ditches between the area of Dukes Road and Pitts Road
- Repaired sinkhole near the culvert at 496 Adams Road
- Repaired washout around outlet of 60-inch cross drain at the creek on Cook Road
- Removed all cypress trees at the Board of Commissioners office in preparation for the parking lot to be paved

Driveway Permits

- Inspected driveway on Concord Road
- Inspected and approved driveways on Kings Road, Salter Road, McKinley Road, West Fossett Road, Millie Trail, Reidsboro Road, Roberts Quarters Road, and Tanyard Road
- Collected \$400 in Driveway Permit fees.

Rotational Road Maintenance

- Motor graders worked into the evenings during the week of June 22nd getting the roads back in shape after the major storms from the previous weekend. Graders have been in the Hunter Road, Caldwell Road, Kendrick Road, and Perkins Road area. They are currently in the Calvary Road and River Road area.
- The long-arm mowers are currently in the River Road, Caldwell Bridge Road, and Old Zebulon Road area.
- Paved road mowing crews are in the Kings Road, Rose Hill Road, and Flat Shoals Road area.

Shop

- The Public Works shop continues to complete maintenance on all county owned vehicles to include hoses, belts, brakes, tires, and oil changes. As well as servicing all Public Works equipment.
